### Mustafa Hulusi

The letter in Hulusi's hand explains that his film "Afyon" — meditative shots of opium poppy fields in Turkey — has just been accepted into the Tate's collection. "The poppy was an aid for worship in pagan times," explains the London artist, whose multi-disciplinary work explores his Turkish-Cypriot heritage. "It was used by assassins, and for the first medical procedures. And then of course there's the political dimension with the Opium Wars and Afghanistan now. It's quite an amazing flower."
